

WMAS TROPHIES

Ladies Cup: Highest Recurve Score

Gents Shield: Highest Recurve Score

Junior Recurve Trophy: Highest Junior Recurve Score

(Junior Boy/Girl shooting in or above their age group)

Junior Compound Trophy: Highest Junior Compound Score

(Junior Boy/Girl shooting in or above their age group)

WMAS & OPEN MEDALS

Medals will be awarded in each class (Recurve, Compound, Longbow and Barebow) and any age and gender group according to the entry as follows:

1 to 3 archers 1st only
4 to 5 archers 1st and 2_{nd}
6 or more archers 1_{st}, 2nd and 3_{rd}

ROUNDS

All archers will be shooting on circular straw bosses on H stands.

Western are made up of eight dozen arrows with six arrows to be shot in timed ends of four minutes, and comprise four dozen arrows at each of the following distances:

WESTERN 60 and 50 yards (Gents, Ladies and Boys under 18)

SHORT WESTERN 50 and 40 yards (Girls under 18 and Boys under 16)

JUNIOR WESTERN 40 and 30 yards (Girls under 16 and Boys under 14)

SHORT JUNIOR WESTERN 30 and 20 yards (Girls under 14 and Boys under 12)

NB: Ages are at the date of the Tournament, **NOT** the date of entry.
