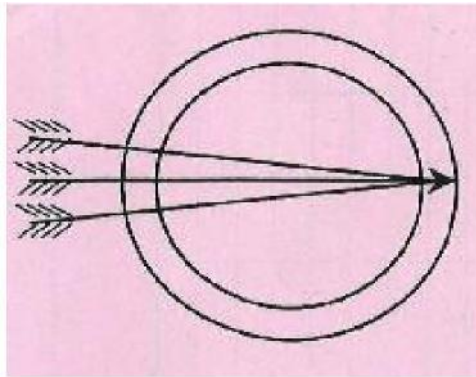

THE AWARDS

WMAS TROPHIES

Ladies Cup:	Highest Recurve Score
Gents Shield:	Highest Recurve Score
Junior Lady Recurve Trophy:	Highest Junior Recurve Score (Junior Lady shooting in or above their age group)
Junior Gent Recurve Trophy:	Highest Junior Recurve Score (Junior Gent shooting in or above their age group)
Junior Compound Trophy:	Highest Junior Compound Score (Junior Lady/Gent shooting in or above their age group)

WMAS & OPEN MEDALS

Medals will be awarded in each class (Recurve, Compound, Longbow and Barebow) and any age and gender group according to the entry as follows:

1 to 3 archers	1 st only
4 to 5 archers	1 st and 2 nd
6 or more archers	1 st , 2 nd and 3 rd

ROUNDS

All archers will be shooting on circular straw bosses on H stands.

Western are made up of eight dozen arrows with six arrows to be shot in timed ends of four minutes, and comprise four dozen arrows at each of the following distances:

WESTERN	60 and 50 yards (Gents, Ladies and Jnr Gents under 18)
SHORT WESTERN	50 and 40 yards (Jnr Ladies under 18 and Jnr Gents under 16)
JUNIOR WESTERN	40 and 30 yards (Jnr Ladies under 16 and Jnr Gents under 14)
SHORT JUNIOR WESTERN	30 and 20 yards (Jnr Ladies under 14 and Jnr Gents under 12)

NB: Ages are at the date of the Tournament, **NOT** the date of entry. If you have any queries regarding the Tournament please contact the Tournament Organiser.
