## REGISTRATION & SIGHTERS

Registration is between 8:15 and 9:00 am each day. Archers entering for the Double Rounds will be required to register on **both days**. Assembly will be at 9:15 and sighters at 9:30 am on both days.

The GNAS Rules of Shooting and dress regulations will apply.

## ROUNDS

### Leamington and Midland Counties Archery Meeting

Ladies & Junior Girls LMC Championship:  
Recurve, Compound, Longbow & Barebow                      Double Hereford

Gentlemen & Junior Boys LMC Championship:  
Recurve, Compound, Longbow & Barebow                      Double York

A separate non Championship single York, Hereford round will be held for archers shooting on one day only, either Saturday or Sunday

Juniors: According to Age    Double Bristol I – V

Juniors wishing to compete for the senior Championship trophies must shoot the appropriate senior round and pay senior fees.

Double round entries received prior to the closing date will take preference over single round entries, early entry is appreciated.

**Please note:** Straw (Egertec) bosses on **H** frames will be used on all Gents targets. Please use suitable arrows.

This is a sports field therefore all arrows **must** be found.

Arrows will be shot in timed ends of **SIX**.

**Longbows:** Where possible we will endeavour to put longbow archers on the same or adjacent targets

## **Scoring**

Scores will be recorded using a double scoring system. Each set of sheets will, at all times, be completed by different archers. At the completion of each end, the scorers will compare and agree totals. In the event of any discrepancies between the two sets of scores the lower score will, in all cases, apply. All amendments to the recorded arrows will be witnessed and signed by the one of the Judges.

We would be very grateful if parents of juniors shooting the Bristol rounds, who are not competing themselves, would assist in scoring duties (but not scoring the same target as their own child).

## **Drug Testing**

As the Tournament has been granted GNAS Record and Rose Status it will be liable for drug testing and any competitors approached to give samples must comply; if they refuse, that refusal will be treated as a positive result. Parents or Guardians must authorise drugs testing of Junior Archers on the entry form.

## **Fees**

Double Rounds	Adults: £18.00	Juniors: £10.00

Juniors who wish to be entered for the Senior Awards (other than the Team Trophies) may do so, but only on payment of the Senior Fees.

## **Caravans and Tents**

Targets will be available for practice from Friday evening on RLSAS's shooting ground, adjacent to the Tournament Field.

## **Dogs**

Dogs are allowed but must be kept on a lead at all times and must not be allowed on the playing surfaces.

## **Barbecue**

We will have a BBQ at OL's Clubhouse on the Saturday evening after shooting has finished, and all archers, families and friends are welcome to join us. Please bring your own food, bar will be open till late.

## LEAMINGTON & MIDLAND COUNTIES ARCHERY MEETING - THE AWARDS

**No Trophies, Shields or Non Medal awards will be given to the winning competitors. We will have a Photographer on duty to take a picture of the Winner with the Trophy and these will be processed and passed to the winners at a later date. These awards will then be handed back to RLSAS officials.**

The reason for doing this is that, as some of you will I am sure be very aware, the trophies, shields and various other awards given out at this meeting are very old and also very valuable. So, we have decided that if these beautiful Awards are to last for another hundred plus years, then this is the way to ensure it happens.

We will be handing out as normal the L&MC Medals, a very distinctive medal well worth winning, and also the RLSAS medals, which are kept by winning competitors.

All rounds to have medals awarded according to entry as detailed below

**LMC medals:** Awarded for senior and junior double York and Hereford rounds for each bow type where there are a minimum of 2 entries.

Trophies are also awarded (subject to the above) for the following rounds:

- Double York: Senior Gent Recurve, Senior Gent Compound, Senior Gent Longbow & Junior Gent Recurve
- Double Hereford: Senior Lady Recurve, Senior Lady Compound, Senior Lady Longbow & Junior Lady Recurve
- Team award for 3 recurve archers from a club shooting Double York &/or Double Hereford
- Single Hereford: Senior Lady Recurve, Senior Lady Compound, Senior Lady Longbow
- Single York: Senior Gent Recurve, Senior Gent Compound, Senior Gent Longbow

All single and double rounds with sufficient archers will be awarded RLSAS medals where junior or senior archers are shooting the appropriate round for their category.

**RLSAS Medals: 1 - 3 entries 1<sup>st</sup> only; 4 - 8 entries 1<sup>st</sup> and 2<sup>nd</sup> only; 9 or more entries 1<sup>st</sup>, 2<sup>nd</sup> and 3<sup>rd</sup>.**

## WEST MIDLANDS ARCHERY SOCIETY SENIOR CHAMPIONSHIPS - THE AWARDS

The senior championships are for senior ladies and gents from the WMAS regions shooting a Hereford or York round respectively. The Team Award is for senior archers unless a junior is shooting a senior round.

The Team Award is for senior archers unless a junior is shooting a senior round. Team of three, must include one Lady, may include maximum of one compound, if lady compound others in team must be gentlemen and not compound.

Awards are based on the Saturday single scores whether the archers are shooting a single or double round. Awards available for Recurve, Compound, Longbow and Barebow depending on entries as below:

**WMAS Medals: 1 - 3 entries 1<sup>st</sup> only; 4 - 6 entries 1<sup>st</sup> and 2<sup>nd</sup> only; 7 or more entries 1<sup>st</sup>, 2<sup>nd</sup> and 3<sup>rd</sup>.**
