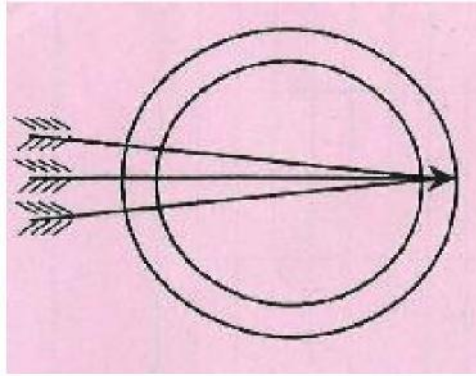

NOVICE is defined, for this purpose of this tournament, as an archer who has **NOT** been a member of
AGB before 1st of January of the year preceding this Tournament, namely 1st of January 2019, and have
not competed in the event before, irrespective of age or bow type.

BOSSES – all bosses will be round straw (Egertec) sitting on wide square frames. Foam targets might be
used, subject to availability.

ARROWS – will be shot in timed ends of six with two details, one end of sighters at first distance.

DRESS CODE – AGB Rule 307 on dress regulations will apply.

PHOTOGRAPHY – In view of the provisions of the Archery GB Protection of Children and Vulnerable Adults
Policy, any person who wishes to take photographs or video footage with camera **or** mobile phone at the
Tournament must register their intention with the Organiser on the appropriate form.

GDRP – When you enter this competition the following information is collected and may be shared with
AGB, tournament organisers, scoring systems and other competitors. For example, when target lists and
results are published: First Name, Surname, Gender, Bow style, Age category, Club, County, Region, Round
(unless defined by age), Disabled (Y/N), Disability info. Other information, such as Date of Birth, AGB
Number, Email and Phone Number will be used solely by the tournament organisers and will not be shared.

RAFFLE – There will be a raffle, if you are able to donate a prize it would be much appreciated.

REFRESHMENTS – There will be coffee, tea, soft drinks and cakes for sale all day.

THE AWARDS

WMAS TROPHIES

Ladies Cup:	Highest Recurve Score
Gents Shield:	Highest Recurve Score
Junior Lady Recurve Trophy:	Highest Junior Recurve Score (Junior Lady shooting in or above their age group)
Junior Gent Recurve Trophy:	Highest Junior Recurve Score (Junior Gent shooting in or above their age group)
Junior Compound Trophy:	Highest Junior Compound Score (Junior Boy/Girl shooting in or above their age group)

WMAS & OPEN MEDALS

Medals will be awarded in each class (Recurve, Compound, Longbow and Barebow), round, age and gender according to the entry as follows:

1 to 3 archers	1 st only
4 to 5 archers	1 st and 2 nd
6 or more archers	1 st , 2 nd and 3 rd

ROUNDS

Windsors are a total of nine dozen arrows with six arrows to be shot in timed ends of four minutes, comprising three dozen arrows at each of the following distances:

WINDSOR	60/50/40 yards (Gents, Ladies and Jnr Gents under 18)
SHORT WINDSOR	50/40/30 yards (Jnr Lady under 18 and Jnr Gent under 16)
JUNIOR WINDSOR	40/30/20 yards (Jnr Lady under 16 and Jnr Gent under 14)
SHORT JUNIOR WINDSOR	30/20/10 yards (Jnr Lady under 14 and Jnr Gent under 12)

122cm target faces and 5-zone scoring (9, 7, 5, 3, 1) will be used. Rolling details will be applied, shooting first archers A&B followed by C&D and then C&D followed by A&B and so on.

NB: Ages are at the date of the Tournament, **NOT** the date of entry. If you have any queries regarding the Tournament please contact the Tournament Organiser.
