Post Lockdown Covid-19 Guidelines for use of RLSAS Archery Facilities

In line with the Government's easing of Covid-19 Restrictions the RLSAS archery range will be returning to the pre Covid-19 rules, regulations and risk assessments, all of which are available on the RLSAS web site, along with some sensible guidelines as given below.

- If you have recently been to the club and then test positive for Covid-19, can you please inform the Secretary of this fact.
- If you arrive at the club and subsequently feel unwell, please leave the club immediately and if you take a test which proves positive, inform the club Secretary.
- Online Booking is no longer a requirement. The "Signing in" book will be put back in place in the club house and <u>ALL members must sign in when they</u> <u>arrive at the club and sign out before leaving the club.</u>
- The club house is now open for members to use wearing of a mask inside
 the clubhouse is down to individuals to do as they see fit, but it is
 recommended that members do wear one if there are more than a couple of
 people inside.
- Target faces and pins are now available inside the club house together with the rangefinder and arrow puller
- Hand sanitiser and disinfectant wipes will still be available for all members to use and will be provided by the club.
- The benches are available outside for members to put their kit together on, once you have done this please remove your bags so others can make use of them.
- Flags are to be put out as per normal rules.
- Three bosses only are to remain on the field if more are brought onto the field of play then bosses must be removed so that only three remain when you leave, irrespective of whether you brought them on or not.
- Be prepared to share bosses with other archers, but only if you feel comfortable with this, and please ask the person who is on the target before doing so. If they decline, respect it.

It is for all archers to try and make the club as safe and as welcoming as they can for themselves and other members. Please respect other members' right to wear a mask should they wish and also to respect their personal space.
