

## Target Archery Indoor Rounds

This table gives the number of dozens of arrows to be shot at each distance, and the target face size, for AGB and WA rounds.

Archers may shoot any of the rounds below. However, dependent upon your gender and age, not all rounds may be used for your Handicap, Classification or Club Records. For more details on individual rounds consult the online AGB Rules of shooting, Rules 403 - 409a, and the RLSAS online list of Club Records.
